

**NATIONAL JUNIOR HONOR SOCIETY
IMMACULATE HEART OF MARY SCHOOL
FACTSHEET 2021**

- Eligibility:** 7th and 8th grade students with a cumulative average of 95.75 (based on cumulative average from sixth grade to the end of the second trimester of seventh grade) and with no discipline points during the year of application. Any student who has received points during the year of application will not be considered for membership until the following year.
- Invitation:** Eligible students will receive a letter after the second trimester report card inviting them to apply for membership.
- Application:** Students who qualify and choose to apply for membership must complete an application form including a document detailing their experience in the areas of leadership, service, and citizenship; they must obtain recommendations from three faculty members. All materials must be submitted to the Faculty Adviser on or before the stated deadline.
- Review:** Applications are reviewed and voted upon by the members of the Faculty Council. Students will be notified of their acceptance or non-acceptance subsequent to the vote.
- Acceptance:** Students who agree to accept the offer of membership in NJHS must complete the notification form and submit the dues by the date specified in their acceptance materials.
- Induction:** Members are inducted into NJHS at a ceremony in the spring.
- Obligation:** Members of NJHS are required to complete service hours and attend all society meetings. They must maintain their cumulative average of 95.75 or higher and be free of disciplinary points. Members who do not meet this criteria will be placed on probation and could be dismissed from the Society.
- Officers:** Members will hold election of officers (President, Vice President, Secretary, and Treasurer); terms of service will begin in the fall.
